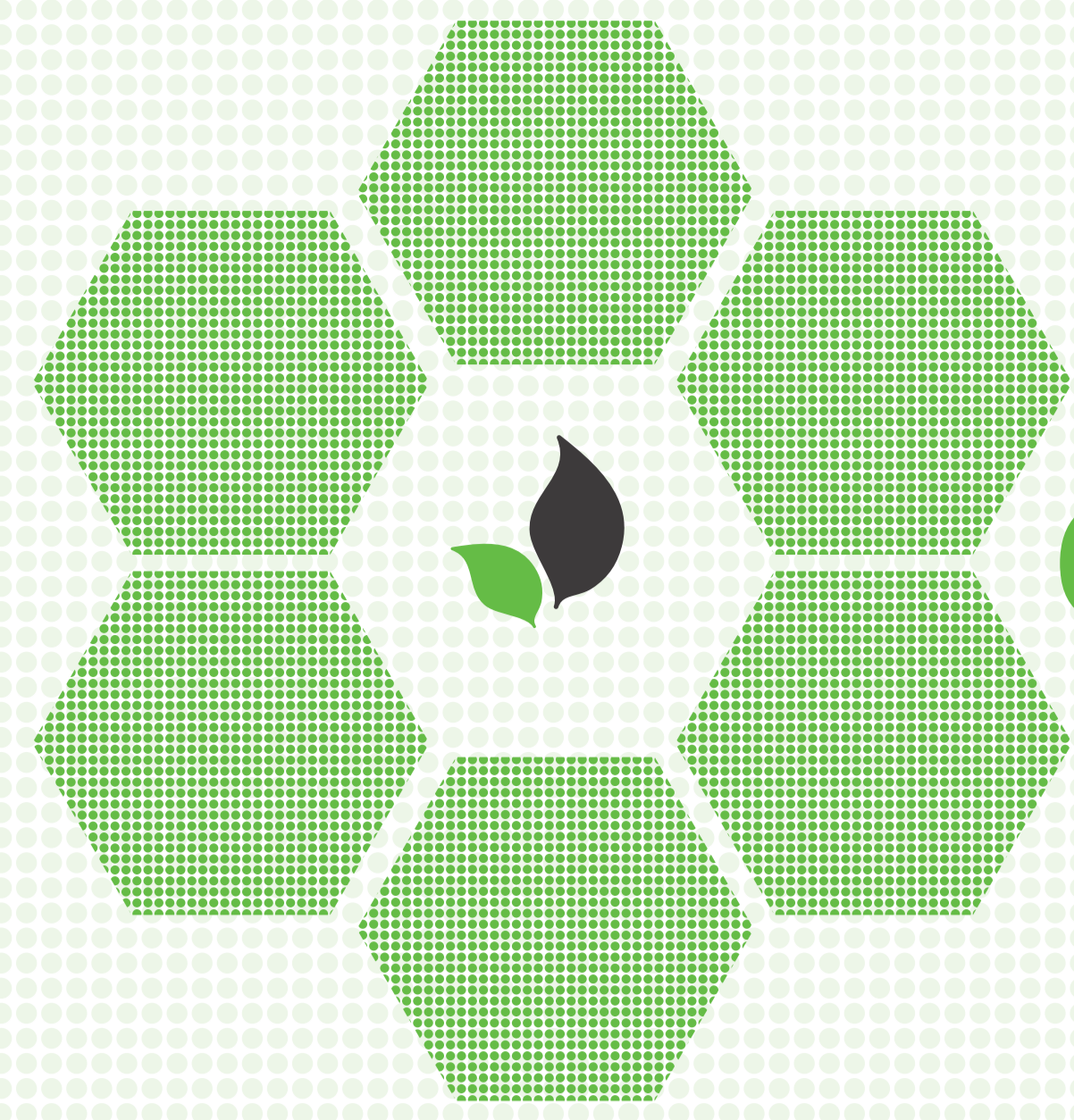
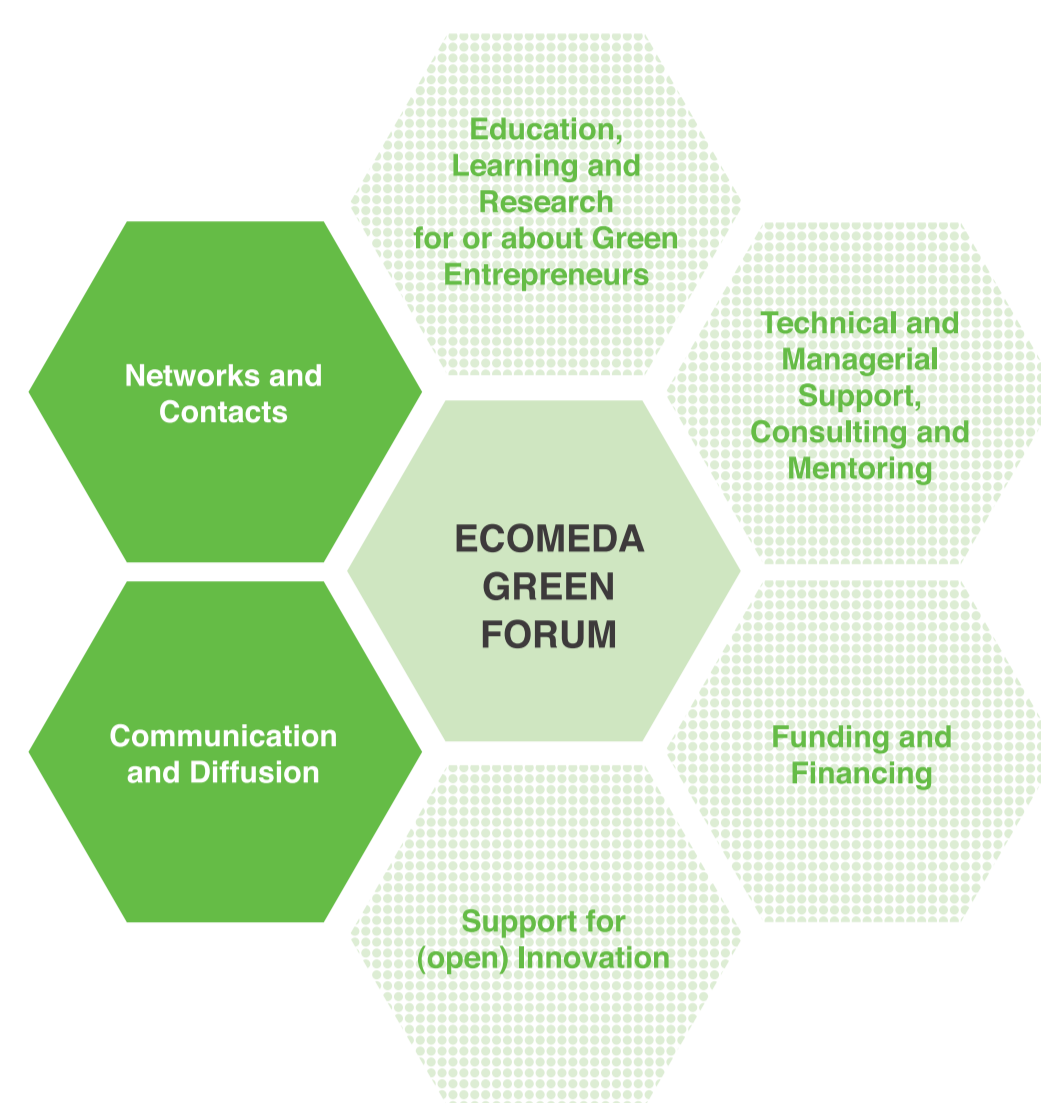

ECOMEDA GREEN FORUM

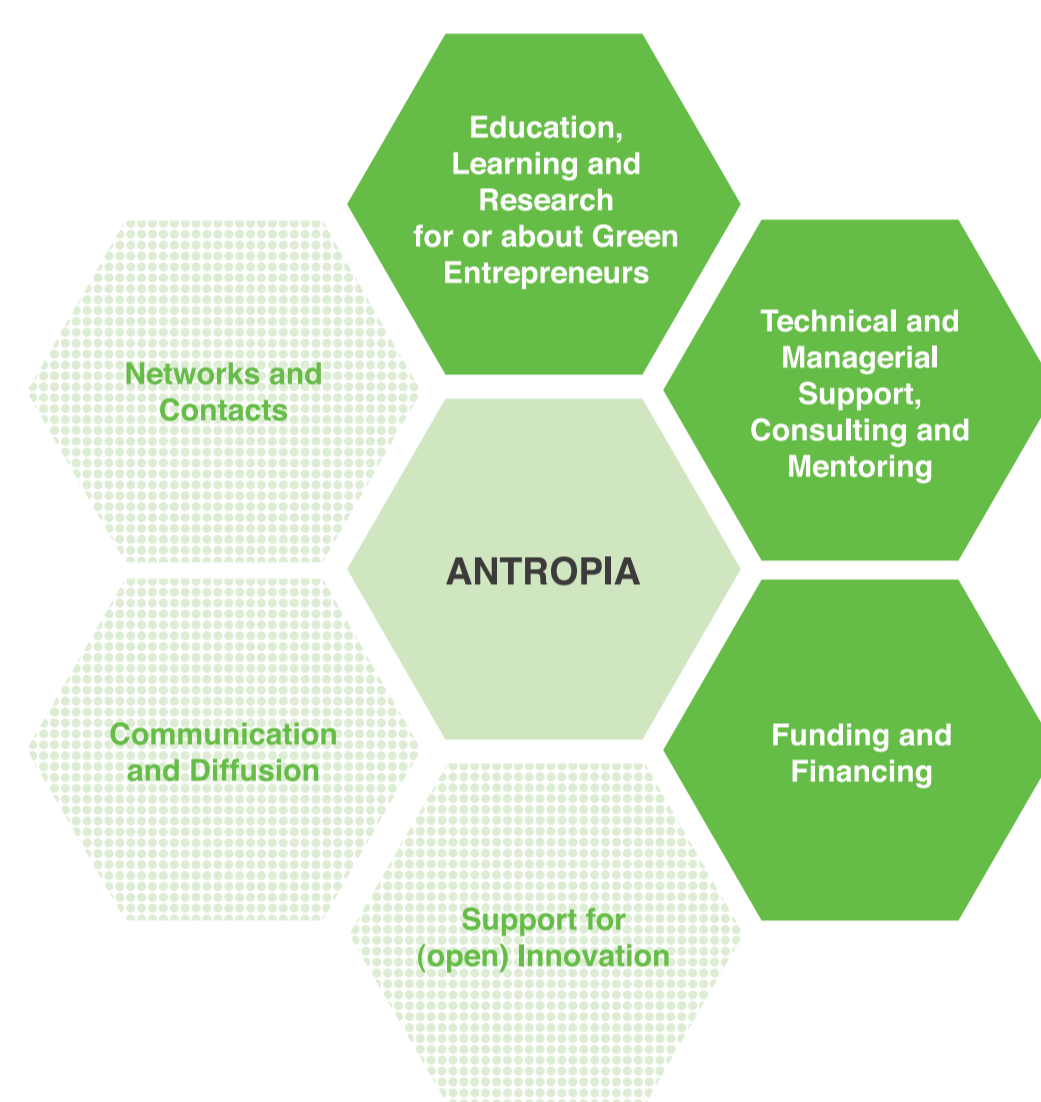

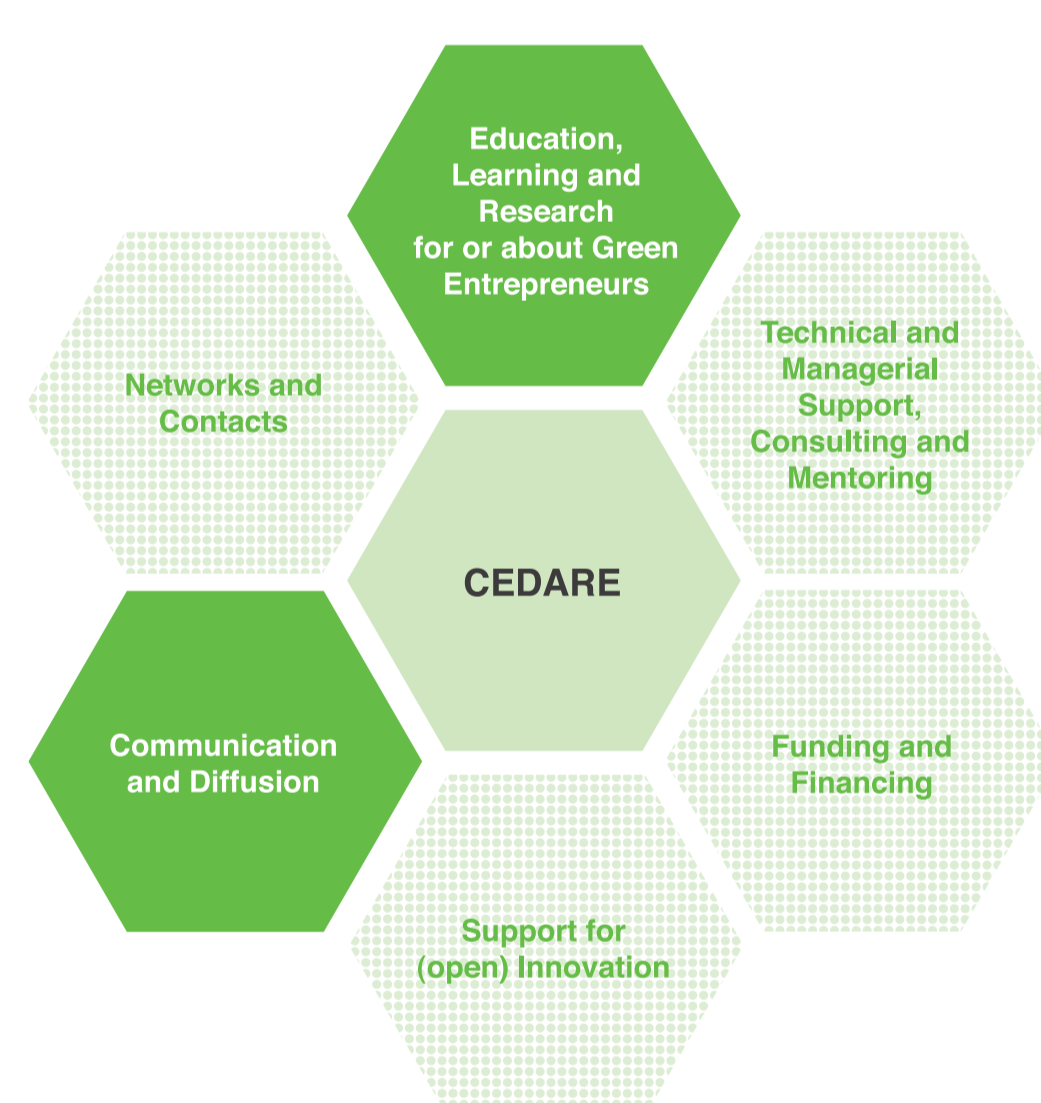

- Promoting the emergence of new social /ecoentrepreneurs in Ile-de-France, thereby developing sustainable projects with high social value.
- Creating a network of social entrepreneurs likely to engage themselves in supporting and promoting social entrepreneurship.
- Evaluating and analyzing this system to extract learnings for teaching, applied research and methods of replication, both on the national territory and abroad.

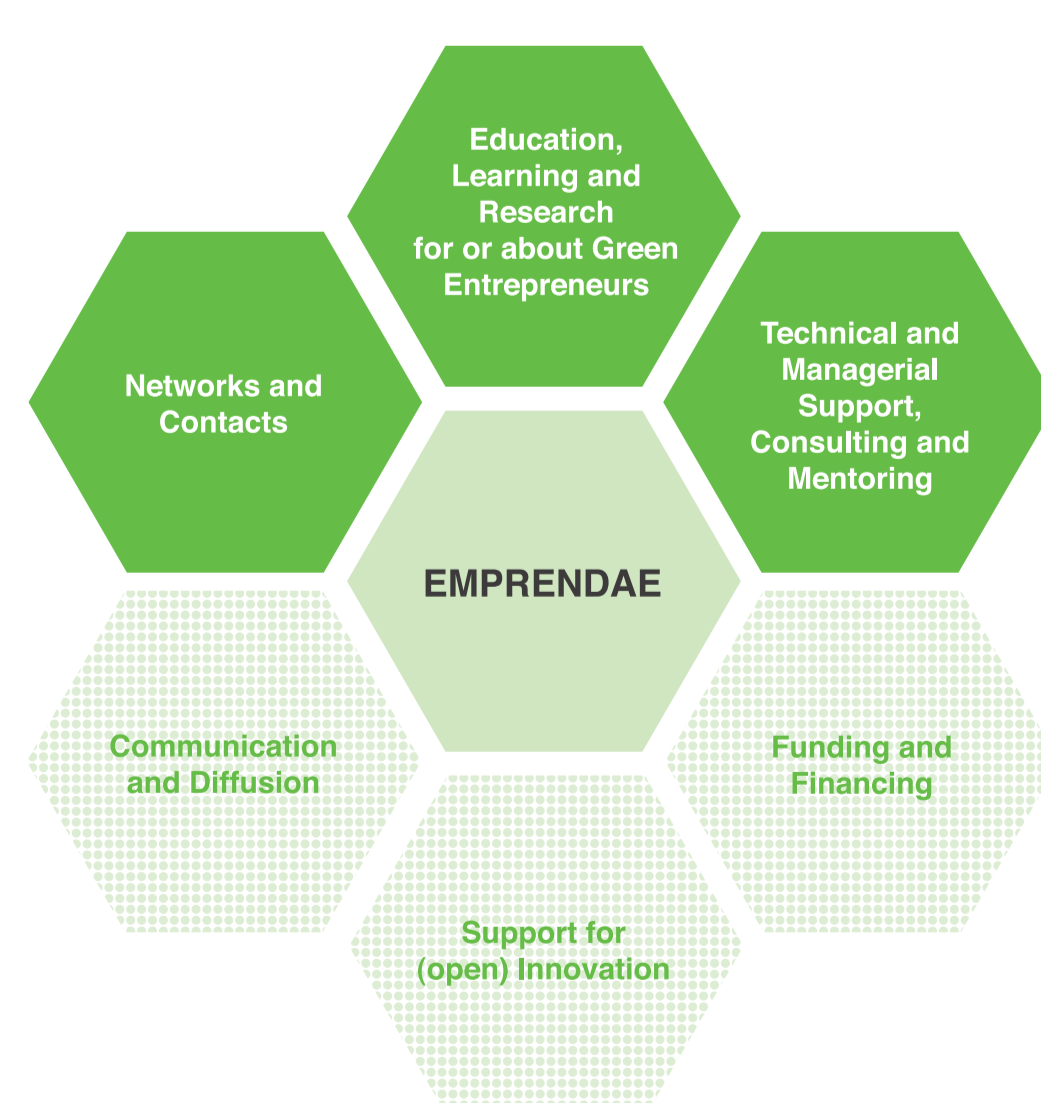
